

ATJ GRANTS SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS THAT PROVIDE LEGAL ASSISTANCE IN THREE AREAS: (A) UNDERSERVED AREAS IN DC; (B) HOUSING-RELATED MATTERS; AND (C) TO SUPPORT A SHARED LEGAL SERVICES INTERPRETER BANK. SINCE 2007, OVER \$40 MILLION HAS BEEN AWARDED TO PROVIDE CRITICAL LEGAL ASSISTANCE TO DC'S POOR AND UNDERSERVED.

IN 2018, THE FIRST YEAR OF GRANT PROGRAM, THE DC BAR FOUNDATION AWARDED OVER \$4.1 MILLION TO LEGAL AID ORGANIZATIONS THAT ARE PROVIDING LEGAL REPRESENTATION TO LOW-INCOME DC TENANTS FACING EVICTION PROCEEDINGS IN LANDLORD-TENANT COURT.

THESE GRANTS ARE FUNDED BY PRIVATE CONTRIBUTIONS AND REVENUE RECEIVED THROUGH THE INTEREST ON LAWYERS TRUST ACCOUNTS (IOLTA) PROGRAM, A PROGRAM CREATED BY THE DISTRICT OF COLUMBIA COURT OF APPEALS IN 1985. IN 2015 AND 2016, THE DC BAR FOUNDATION RECEIVED MONEY FROM THREE BANK SETTLEMENTS. THE FOUNDATION CREATED THREE, ONE-TIME GRANT PROGRAMS WITH THESE FUNDS. THESE GRANTS WERE AWARDED TO
